

The Hamptons of Duluth Pool Party Instructions

Pool parties with 6 or more guests from outside the neighborhood required that a request be sent to the Board of Directors for approval to include the following:

1. How many will be attending?
2. Who will be responsible for guest conduct at the pool?

Once approved the requester will be responsible for coordinating and paying for one or more additional lifeguards.

If the party comprises 11 or more guests from outside the neighborhood. check with AMS Pools (770-932-6389) to determine the number required.

Following are AMS Pools requirements for hosting a pool party:

- Requester understands that homeowners have priority for the pool use and if the guest causes interference with homeowners they are responsible to correct their guests and if not, the requester will be held responsible and could lose pool privileges and be asked to leave the pool area.
- Customer agrees to provide one (1) chaperone for every 5 individuals under the age of 18 yrs old.
- All parties must be booked at least one (3) week prior to the party date to allow enough time to schedule lifeguards. Parties booked less than one (2) week in advance will be charged a \$125 "rush" fee to offset the costs related to last minute scheduling. (Checks written to "Hamptons of Duluth")
- Homeowners arranging a pool party that requires extra lifeguards is at the homeowner's expense and responsibility for coordinating with AMS. HOA is not responsible.
- Customer agrees to schedule their pool party during regular pool hours.
- All payments are to be submitted directly through the AMS Pools website or the main office. Lifeguards cannot accept pool party payments.
- Credit card payments or checks must be received at least five (10) business days prior to the scheduled party.
- Customer may be charged a \$125 cleanup fee if the pool and surrounding area is not cleaned up and/ or is left in poor condition.
- For cancellations due to weather please work out the details with AMS prior to booking of event. The Community is not responsible for any fee's lost due to cancellations.
- If your pool party requires 1 or more lifeguards go to www.amspoolsga.com, select "Pool Parties" from the menu on the upper right and follow the instructions. You can pay for the lifeguards by credit card on the AMS Pools website.
- No glass is allowed on the pool deck or in the pool. No food allowed in the pool. No diving, no screaming etc. Any violation could result in suspension of pool privileges from a week to a season.
